

GOEXHIBIT!™ BADGE SCANNING SETUP

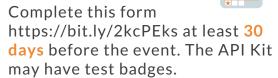
It's easy to set up GoExhibit!™ for badge scanning at your events by following the process below.

CONTACT EVENT ORGANIZER



Contact the event organizer and purchase an API Kit. It may also be called a Software Developer's Kit, or SDK.

SEND API KIT



5 EVENT-SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS



Follow any additional event-specific instructions from Lead Liaison support.

7 TEST PRODUCTION BADGE



If possible, obtain a production badge from the event organizer as early as possible and do a scan.

QUESTIONS?



Reply to the email you received in #4 above if you have any questions or concerns to create a support ticket.

9 CREATE FORM



INTEGRATION



Lead Liaison will integrate the badge provider with your form. You'll be notified by event-team@leadliaison.com when your form is ready.

6 TEST



Do a scan using your test badge.

TEST PRODUCTION BADGE, AGAIN



At a minimum, scan your badge a day before your event using the actual badge issued to you when you checkin at the event.



GOEXHIBIT!™ BADGE SCANNING SETUP FAQ'S

? WHAT IF THE SHOW PROVIDER DOES NOT OFFER A DEVELOPER'S KIT?

Lead Liaison also offers automatic post-show data merge, also known as post-show reconciliation. This method may be used when lead retrieval providers do not offer a Developer's Kit for integration.

HOW CAN I TEST THE BADGES?

The lead retrieval provider should provide a test badge and a production badge. If the lead retrieval provider only provides a test badge, then you'll need to provide Lead Liaison with a production badge at least 24 hours in advance. Typically, you will get your production badge by mail or during the check-in process.

WHAT BADGE TYPES DO YOU SUPPORT?

GoExhibit! supports badge scanning for barcodes, QR codes, and even NFC (Near Field Communication) badges!

WHICH PROVIDERS DO YOU INTEGRATE WITH?

GoExhibit! integrates with any provider that has an API kit. We currently integrate with: Cvent, Experient, Conexsys, Expo Leads, iLeads.com, ExpoBadge, CompuSystems, Convention Data Services, Experient, ATS, ITN, and more. *Note: Even if you see your show's provider on this list, you still need to follow the process above. API documentation can change from show to show. It is important you send us everything you receive from the show organizer.
